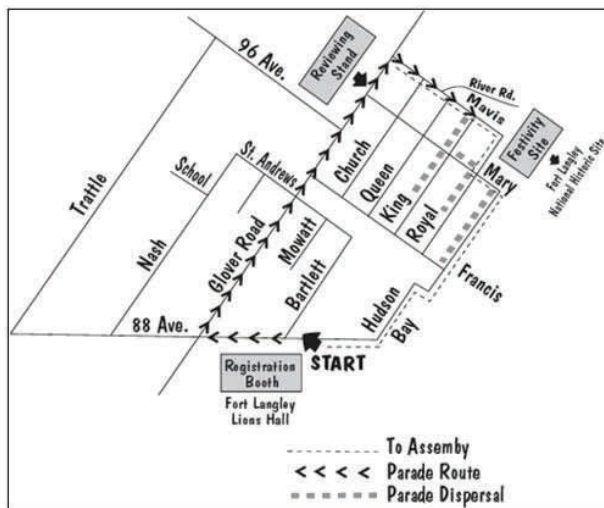

86th Annual May Day Parade and Festival

Monday, May 19

The Lions Club kicks off the day with a **pancake breakfast** at the Lions Hall on the corner of Glover and 88th Avenue from 8:00 - 10:30 am. Cost is \$5 for adults and \$3 for kids. The **parade begins at 11:00 am** on Glover Road, and includes marching bands, the Vancouver Police motorcycle drill team, the May Queen and her Court, and many fun floats and personalities. To commemorate BC's 150th birthday and the heritage of Fort Langley as the birthplace of BC where it all began, the parade route has been reversed to begin at the Fort Langley Lions Hall and ending up at the Fort Langley National Historic Site for the Festival in the Park following the parade. The **festival begins at 12:30 pm** (following the parade), with the traditional Maypole Dancing, kiddie amusement rides and a midway of carnival games, children's entertainment and face painting, live music and entertainment, a Marketplace with vendors, and food concession including the famous Freybe's sausage on a bun and the Fort Langley Lions Chicken BBQ.
